




## FUTURE SIMPLE with WILL (Beginner)

<p>1. Voluntary action.</p> 	<p>Are you hungry? I <b>will make</b> you a sandwich.</p> <p>I <b>will turn down</b> the TV; it is too loud.</p> <p>Do you want coffee? I <b>will make</b> you some.</p> <p>I <b>will help</b> you clean your apartment.</p>
<p>2. Promise</p> 	<p>I <b>will do</b> my homework tonight. I promise!</p> <p>I <b>will love</b> you forever. I <b>won't stop</b> loving you.</p> <p>Can I borrow \$100? I <b>will pay</b> you next week.</p> <p>I <b>will buy</b> you a souvenir on my next vacation.</p>
<p>3. Future Prediction</p> 	<p>I think it <b>will rain</b> tomorrow.</p> <p>It <b>won't snow</b> this month.</p> <p>He <b>will be</b> the next President.</p> <p>The USA <b>won't win</b> the next World Cup.</p>
