





### Future Simple: Be Going To (Beginner)

Signal Words	Form
<p>Today....                      Tomorrow....                      Soon...                      Someday...                      This....(afternoon, week, month, etc.)                      Next... (week, year, month, etc.)  <b>ANY FUTURE TIME</b></p>	<p>I + <b>AM</b> + GOING TO + V1                      He/She/It + <b>IS</b> + GOING TO + V1                      You/We/They + <b>ARE GOING TO</b> + V1</p>
<p>1. Future Plan</p>  <p>LANGUAGE  N</p>	<p>I <b>am not going to go</b> to the beach after class. I <b>am going to go</b> to the gym.</p> <p>Tomorrow he <b>is going to visit</b> Orlando.</p> <p>We <b>are going to eat</b> sushi tonight.</p> <p>She <b>is going to graduate</b> University next year.</p>
<p>2. Future Prediction</p>  <p>LANGUAGE  N</p>	<p>My son <b>is going to be</b> the President someday.</p> <p>She <b>is going to come</b> late tomorrow because she <b>is going to go</b> to a party tonight.</p> <p>I don't think it <b>is going to snow</b> next winter.</p> <p>I <b>am not going to win</b> the lottery anytime soon.</p>
<p>*** Both "WILL" and "BE GOING TO" can be used to talk about future predictions and have the same meaning.</p>
