


Used To: Simple Past (Beginner)

We can use USED TO when speaking about repeated or regular activities or habits in THE PAST. Be careful, you cannot use the USED TO form when talking about an action that only occurred (happened) once or a few times.

Form	
<p>STATEMENTS:</p> <p>Subject + USED TO + V1 Subject + DIDN'T USE TO + V1</p>	<p>QUESTIONS:</p> <p>DID + Subject + USE TO + V1 ?</p>
<p>Use: We can use used to when speaking about repeated or regular activities or habits in the past.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p>Where did you use to live? I used to live in Korea.</p> <p>Did you use to smoke? No, I didn't use to smoke.</p> <p>Who did Pamela use to date? She used to date Tommy.</p> <p>I used to go to the gym a lot, but I stopped when I had a baby.</p>
<p>Sometimes we can use the Simple Past with the same meaning as when we use <i>used to</i>. Compare the following examples:</p>	
<p>Simple Past</p> <p>Where DID you GO on vacation when you were a child?</p> <p>I WENT to the mountains every summer.</p>	<p>Used To</p> <p>Where DID you USE TO go on vacation when you were a child?</p> <p>I USED TO GO to the mountains every summer.</p>
